Adoption Criteria

Thank you for showing your interest in adopting one of our Byfleet Cat Rescue cats. Before we can consider you as an adopter we require you to read through the below adoption criteria and submit an application to ensure you meet all the requirements.

Please read the below criteria for adoption before you apply for a home check

We take great care to ensure that the right cat goes to the right home, therefore we do not operate on a 'first come first serve' basis. Instead, we match up potential owners carefully from the information provided in the application/home check form together with the photos of the living space and garden.

Minimum age to adopt is 18 years. Our adoption fee is £150

- If you are seeking an outdoor cat, your application will be rejected if you live near a main road. This is due to the high risk of road traffic accidents involving cats on main roads. You may still be considered for an indoor cat if you are serious about keeping the cat indoors
- No venomous animals
- You must follow the advice/guidelines provided upon adoption of the cat
- You become financially responsible for all veterinary bills at the time of adoption

Documentation you will need to provide at time of application:

- Photos of your living space and garden (if you have one)
- A driving licence (full or provisional) or a utility bill dated within the last 3 months which includes your name and full address - this is to prove you live at the address you have provided
- If living in rented accommodation, written permission must be provided from your landlord to keep a pet in your home.

Please complete the Home Check form as accurately as possible as this will help us when trying to match you with a cat who is looking for their forever home.

Home check rules:

- When submitting your home check form you must attach photos of your living space and garden. Unfortunately, applications without photos will not be considered
- If you are applying for an outdoor cat, please kindly note that your application will not be considered if you live near a main road
- You must attach a recent utility bill (dated within the last 3 months) which shows your name and full address as proof that you reside at the stated address
- If you live in rented/sheltered accommodation, you will need to provide copies of the permission from your landlord agreeing to you having a cat in your property

How to apply for a cat/kitten

Once completed, please email this form and your photos/documents to adoptions@byfleetcatrescue.co.uk. Once submitted, your application will be reviewed and a member of the team will be in contact with the next steps.

Our promise to you

- All adult cats that leave us for their forever homes will be fully vet checked, vaccinated, neutered & chipped. You will receive a copy of the full medical history for the cat
- All kittens will be fully vet checked & vaccinated (1st & 2nd dose). All kittens that are adopted need to be neutered when they are old enough and you will need to sign a kitten neutering agreement to ensure this is carried out
- Cat & kittens are matched with families who are suited the most, not necessarily who applied first. The wellbeing of the cat is our priority
- The information in this form is confidential and will only be used for the purpose of internal record keeping and communication with you
